## Membership Eligibility:

- Membership in the UAA is open to individuals formerly employed by the United States Agency for International Development or its predecessor agencies for at least two years and who left the Agency in good standing.
- Former civil servants, Foreign Service Officers, Foreign Service Nationals, and third-country nationals are encouraged to join the UAA, as are AD and Schedule C appointees, former employees who were employed through inter-agency service agreements (PASA, RASA), fellowship programs (e.g. AAAS Fellows, Population Fellows), and personal services contracts.
