# Membership Eligibility:

- Membership in the UAA is open to individuals formerly employed by the United States Agency for International Development or its predecessor agencies for at least 18 months.
- Former civil servants, Foreign Service Officers, Foreign Service Nationals, and third-country nationals are encouraged to join the UAA, as are AD and Schedule C appointees, former employees who were employed through inter-agency service agreements (PASA, RASA), fellowship programs (e.g. AAAS Fellows, Population Fellows), and personal services contracts.
